Organizing an Activity

- **Activity Approval:** Submissions will be reviewed for alignment with MDS objectives and added to the Trello Activities Dashboard upon approval.
- **Collaborate and Coordinate:** Engage with other organizers and share ideas via the Trello Activities Dashboard.

- **Digital Toolbox:** Includes resources such as guidelines, templates, and materials to help alumni organize and promote activities effectively.
- **Branding Materials:** Consistent visual assets like logos, banners, and posters to maintain a professional event appearance.
